- Update on tenure as President
  - o Thanks to all staff for the role and importance they play in the functioning of the University
  - Staff governance: Virginia Tech was the first in the state and one of the first in the nation to have a staff person sit on the Board of Visitors. It has been successful here because of the way that those people have carried out that role. Staff governance has been extremely helpful and successful.
  - Since 2000, our square footage has tripled.
  - At any given time, there is \$1.1 billion in renovations going on.
  - Research funding has almost tripled.
  - o All of this is due to our shared commitments.
  - Applauds the sense of commitment at Tech.
  - Average student loan is \$24,000, only 1% goes into default.
  - Believes there will be a large upheaval in the way higher education is financed.
