- This is also for Faculty and Staff.
- Suspect a mistake- miss identification- How to have that conversation. If you're not sure you can use "they" pronoun. Should we correct it if it is an error?
 - o Maybe ask the student to correct the information.

- All of us can go into HokieSpa to update our information.
- Making everyone feel comfortable.
- When you host a meeting give your personal pronouns
 - o If you wish please include your pronouns.
 - o Make it a choice because some individuals may not want to include them.
